Photosynthesis

- 1. Why do you think the leaves of a plant droop at night?
- 2. "Transpiration is a necessary evil". Justify this statement.
- 3. "The leaves of a plant needs to be kept in a dark room for few hours before performing the starch test". What is the reason behind this statement?
- 4. To perform the experiment to show chlorophyll is necessary for photosynthesis, a leaf from variegated plant is taken. Why?
- 5. During photosynthesis the glucose formed is first converted to starch and stored in leaves. What is the reason behind this?

Respiration in plants and animals

- 1. Root of a plant was immersed in a bottle containing alkali solution to which phenolphalein was added. What would be your observation after a few hours? Give reasons in support of your statement.
- 2. A gardener watered the soil using excess water for several days. The plants started to die after a few days. Why?
- 3. A bottle of lime water kept in the laboratory turned milky after a few days. What is the reason behind this?

- 5. "Yeast is used in bakeries for risening of the dough". Which product of anaerobic respiration is used for risening of the dough?
